EVENT DETAILS

Please arrive from **10am** and head to the Trees for Cities marquees and registration area. **All participants must sign-in at the registration table before starting the activity.**

Activity: We will be planting young trees in areas with potentially uneven, muddy ground. This activity can involve digging and lifting as well as using simple hand tools and wheelbarrows.

Background: Trees For Cities is working with London Borough of Tower Hamlets to plant new trees in Millwall Park. The trees are intended to provide future shade, habitats for wildlife and visual interest to paths and spaces in the park.

Trees for Cities will provide: Tools, supervision and training, free lunch and refreshments.

Facilities: There will be toilets (portaloos), handwashing stations, and drinking water on site.
