TREE PLANTING EVENT AT SIPSON RECREATION GROUND SATURDAY 29TH NOVEMBER

10AM - 2PM

EVENT DETAILS

Please arrive from **10am** and head to the Trees for Cities marquees and registration area. **All participants must sign-in at the registration table before starting the activity.**

Activity: We will be planting young trees in areas with potentially uneven, muddy ground. This activity can involve digging and lifting as well as using simple hand tools and wheelbarrows.

Background: This planting day is part of a larger project to add more trees to the park and contribute to London Borough of Hillingdon's tree canopy cover goals. The trees are intended to provide shade, add visual interest and increase biodiversity in the area.

Trees for Cities will provide: Tools, supervision and training, free lunch and refreshments.

Facilities: There will be toilets (portaloos), handwashing stations, and drinking water on site.

The closest station is Heathrow terminal 2&3 station on the Piccadilly and Elizabeth Line. Once there follow the signs to the Heathrow Central Bus Station and take either the 105, 111, 278 or 285 Bus to Sipson Way/Blunts Avenue. From there it is a short 5 min walk to the Recreation ground.


Alternatively take the Elizabeth Line to West Drayton and then the 222 Bus to Sipson Way with a short walk to the Rec ground.

Closest bus routes are 105, 111, 222, 278 and 285.

Sipson Recreation Ground can be accessed from Sipson Way opposite the JA Supermarket or at the end of Ashby Way
