



# Tree and Bulb Planting at Newton Park – Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> November 2021 10am – 2pm

## Volunteer Information Pack and Guidance



<b>Activity</b>	<p>Trees for Cities is delighted to be working in partnership with the London Borough of Harrow to plant 17 new trees and some spring bulbs in Newton Park this autumn. As part of this project we are pleased to be able to hold a community planting day for local residents.</p> <p>Tools, guidance on tree planting and supervision will be provided.</p> <p>We endeavour to make our events safe and welcoming for people of all ages and abilities. While the risk of transmission is quite low during this outdoor event we do ask that attendees help us manage the risk by avoiding congregating at the entrances and exits to the park and around the marquees.</p>
<b>Time</b>	<p>10am – 2pm. Please arrive for 10am to sign in and we will start planting as soon as possible after this. There is no obligation to stay for the whole day if you are unable to.</p>

<b>What to wear and bring</b>	<p>Please bring your own pair of gardening gloves if possible, wear strong boots, bring layers and waterproofs just in case!</p> <p>We will provide a hot lunch for volunteers and there will be snacks available throughout the day.</p> <p>To help us minimise waste please bring a bottle of water, a bowl or Tupperware for lunch and your own cutlery.</p> <p>Trees for Cities cannot be responsible for any lost or stolen belongings. Please bear in mind that anything brought into the park may get muddy.</p>

## Trees for Cities Covid-19 volunteer disclaimer

Before attending any Trees for Cities' community tree planting workshops and events, all volunteers must read the following:
