Location	<p>We will be planting in the near the Charlie Brown Roundabout, you will need to go south on Chigwell road to get to the site as there is no way across the river once you get into the park.</p> <p>The nearest address is Chigwell Road, E18 1NJ. Take the footpath off the road into the park and you should see our green Trees for Cities marquees.</p> <p>While tube strikes are planned for the same day as the planting, busses from Loughton, Ilford, Woodford and Gants Hill stop near the entrance to the park</p> <p>The what3words location for the site entrance is ///racks.dishes.spoil</p>
